

Requirements for Major/Minor Selection

For a student to select a major, he/she must be a Junior. To be a Junior, a sophomore student must earn **all 66 credits** (64 for students exempted from the French courses) **of the freshman and sophomore level courses** (all 100 level and 200 level courses) **and** a cumulative GPA of at least 2. In addition, he/she must have a specialized GPA **of at least 2**. The specialized GPA involves exclusively the courses related to the major of interest, as specified below:

Accounting Major: BCOR 130 and BCOR 225.

Business Analytics Major: BCOR 110, BCOR 111, BCOR 150, BCOR 230, and BCOR 250.

Finance Major: BCOR 130, BCOR 150, and BCOR 260.

Information Technology Major: BCOR 200, CS 100, CS 120, CS 200, and CS 220.

Marketing Major: BCOR 120, BCOR 150, and BCOR 210 (must have at least grade of C in BCOR 210).

You have to submit the form during the registration process.

Note about Double Major and Double Minor

Double Major

For the students who wish to have a double major, they should fulfill all the requirements of two majors. They have to take all the courses related to each major. In addition, **they should complete two different senior projects**.

Double Minor

For the students who wish to have a double minor, they should fulfill all the requirements of the two minors. They have to take all the courses related to each minor. In case that the two minors have one course in common, the common course is counted for one minor only. The student has to take another course from the major courses list to replace it, after the approval of the Head of the department.
